- Automotive Service Excellence (ASE)

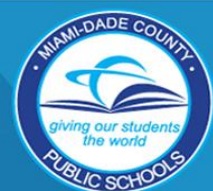
Length of Program:

The average length of this program is 750 hours (approx. 10 months). Open-entry/open-exit is not applicable.

Entrance Requirements:

- Application
- Students must have completed Automotive Service Technology 1
- Interview with a counselor, instructor, and Braman manager
- Assessment in reading, math, and language
- Valid driver's license
- Local background check and pass drug test
- Have a high school diploma or GED
- Adult students must be 17-25 and be officially withdrawn from high school
- Fees for supplies and textbooks required
- Uniform required
