- The Automotive Service Technology Program provides both instruction and hands-on performance of all the basic tasks for initial training for employment in the automotive service field or further training in any or all of the specialty areas. Students are prepared to pass the industry certification exams.

Industry Certification: Automotive Service Excellence (ASE)

Length of Program:

- The average length of this program is 1800 hours (approx. 21 months) for adults attending full-time. Actual time is dependent upon enrollment (full-time/part-time) and length of time the student requires to achieve competencies.

Entrance Requirements:

- Application
- Interview with a counselor
- Adult students must be at least 16 years of age and not attending high school
- Assessment in reading, math, and language
- Fees for supplies, uniforms, and textbooks required
