Certified Dietary Manager

Program Outlook:

- This program is designed to prepare students to manage dietary operations in healthcare facilities such as nursing homes, senior living communities, hospitals, schools, etc.

Program Content:

- Food Service Management
- Nutrition & Medical Nutrition Therapy
- Human Resources Management
- Food Safety/Sanitation



Industry Certifications:

- Certified Dietary Manager (CDM)
- Certified Food Protection Professional (CFPP)

Length of Program:

- The program is 270 hours (approx. 12 months). The program consists of 120 hours of classroom instruction and 150 hours of hands-on practice in dietary management. Actual time is dependent on the length of time the student requires to achieve competencies. The course is offered only in the evening and meets twice a week.

Entrance Requirements:

- Application
- Prerequisite: must have completed the Nutrition and Dietetic Services program or 2 years experience in the field.
- Interview with counselor and instructor
- Adult students must be at least 16 years old and not attending high school
- Submit required level of background check
- Pass physical examination
- Fee for supplies and textbooks required



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
