Length of Program:

The average length of this program is 900 hours (approx. 12 months) for adults attending full-time. Actual time is dependent upon enrollment (full-time/part-time) and the length of time the student requires to achieve competencies.

Entrance Requirements:

- Application
- Interview with a counselor
- Assessment in reading, math, and language
- Adult students must be at least 16 years old and not attending high school
- Fee for supplies and textbooks required
