## Electricity

### Program Outlook:

- The purpose of the Electricity Program is to prepare students for employment or advanced training in a variety of construction/electrical industries.

### Program Content:

- Develop an understanding of basic electricity
- Apply electricity related basic math
- Read and interpret basic electrical codes
- Learn about alternating current (AC) circuit skills
- Install residential wiring
- Safety procedures
- Use of tools, equipment, and materials in the industry
- Employability skills



### Length of Program:

- The average length of this program is 1200 hours (approx. 13 months) for adults attending full-time. Actual time is dependent upon enrollment (full-time/part-time) and the length of time the student requires to achieve competencies.

### Entrance Requirements:

- Application
- Interview with a counselor
- Assessment in reading, math, and language
- Adult students must be at least 16 years old and not attending high school
- Fee for supplies and textbooks required
