Program Outlook:

- The purpose of this program is to prepare students for initial employment as diet clerks.

Program Content:

- Introduction to the dietetic career ladder
- Nutrition and sanitation
- Technical skills in the area of nutrition/food services
- Work under the direction of a certified dietary manager or dietetic technician
- Prepare trays for patients
- Employability skills



Length of Program:

- The program is 300 hours (approx. 4 months) with 8 weeks of classroom instruction and 8 weeks in a clinical setting. Open-entry/open-exit is not applicable.

Entrance Requirements:

- Application
- Interview with counselor and instructor
- Adult students must be at least 16 years old and not attending high school
- Submit required level of background check
- Pass physical examination
- Fee for supplies and textbooks required
- Uniform required
